Why is this study being done?

This study is being done to test a new computerized program for teaching young women with cancer about fertility preservation treatment options such as egg, embryo and ovarian tissue freezing.

Your participation in this research is strictly voluntary & confidential.

You may be eligible to participate in this study if you are:

- Female
- 18-42 years of age
- Diagnosed with cancer
- Willing and able to talk and write about questions related to a new computer program
 - Eligible for egg, embryo, or ovarian tissue freezing





What will you be asked to do?

You will be asked to answer a few brief questions by phone to screen for your eligibility. Then, if you are eligible, you will be asked to complete several questionnaires about your knowledge of fertility preservation and answer a few questions about your background, too. You will also be assigned to one of two computer programs. The computer program has information about fertility preservation. We will also want to talk with you by phone or email about the computer program to see how we might improve the program. It will take about 2 hours to 2 hours 30 minutes to complete all the steps in the study.
